The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF World Cup is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day).

The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.



Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory, however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All Rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one (1) panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two (2) or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

Equipment Control

Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event who are competing for Medals. In addition, up to two (2) additional athletes per event can be entered to compete for Ranking Points Only (RPO).

Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

Maximum Entry / Range Capacity

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete / mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

ISSF and Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Attention: Starting from 2025, all athletes, even with an official ISSF ID number already issued, must sign the updated "Athlete's Declaration" (Edition 2025) once again. Without renewed signature the athlete cannot be registered online and will not be allowed to participate in any ISSF Championship. The ISSF Headquarters communicated all details about this new procedure already in November 2025.

ISSF Member Federations are urged to ensure that all of their athletes who should be registered for the ISSF World Cup Munich 2025 have signed the updated declaration and returned it together with the a copy of the athlete's passport for verification purposes to the ISSF Headquarters at registration@issf-sports.org far ahead of the Final Entry Deadline.

5. Registration Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 - 5) and return them by the established deadlines (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email will not be accepted.

Preliminary Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at https://shootingsportscloud.com.

The Preliminary Entry Deadline is 8 MAR 2025.

Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Final Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at https://shootingsportscloud.com.

The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is 9 MAY 2025.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the **Late Entry Deadline** (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **4 JUN 2025.**

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of status ("Medal" athlete ↔ "RPO" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **5 JUN 2025** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating ISSF Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From 5 JUN 2025 onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.
- b) Status exchange between a registered athlete for competing for Medals and a "RPO" athlete can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (9 MAY 2025) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and officials entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

NO ENTRY FEE PAYMENT MAY BE MADE TO THE ISSF OR THE TRAVEL AGENCY.

Please transfer all payments not later than 9 MAY 2025.

All amounts must be paid in EUR and must include any transfer fees or similar fees that the bank may charge. Take care that all necessary data will be transferred, so that the Organizing Committee can assign payments to the right ISSF Member Federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your Team Leader to bring with him / her to the Entry Confirmation.

All payments made at the shooting range must be paid in cash in EUR or traveler checks (**EUR only**) to the Organizing Committee upon arrival (no credit cards will be accepted).

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT THERE IS NO ATM OR BANK ON THE SHOOTING RANGE OR CLOSE NEARBY.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline) will be prepared in advance by the ISSF and Organizing Committee. During the online registration process, the ISSF Member Federations can upload pictures of their athletes and officials to be displayed on the accreditations. There will be no possibility to take photos for accreditations on the shooting range.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Visa

All ISSF Member Federations that will need an official invitation of the German Shooting Sport Federation are requested to order it before **19 APR 2025**. Please use the Visa Support Form (Annex 5) and return it as a **word document and typed on PC only**.

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be sent by e-mail. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

The German Shooting Sport Federation has **no influence** on the embassies and can provide invitations **for the period of the ISSF World Cup Munich 2025 only!**

Firearm License

You do **not** have to declare **air guns** and air gun ammunition at all, if they conform to the international standard. Please note: To import air guns without an auxiliary permission, they must have the international embossing / stamping "F".



Owners of a **European Firearms Passport (EFP)** may even import their small-bore rifles and pistols **without** an auxiliary permission to Germany.

All nations that do **not** belong to the **European Union** must use the provided online registration to **register their small-bore** rifles and pistols as well as the proper ammunition. ISSF Member Federations using the Online Firearm Registration are entitled to enter or alter entries regarding firearms and ammunition until **4 JUN 2025**. Changes after the deadline of 4 JUN 2025 can be made by the Organizing Committee only. Please register online until **4 JUN 2025** at https://shootingsportscloud.com.

The Online Firearm Registration is expected to be available from the beginning of May 2025.

After the online registration of your firearms and ammunition you will receive a **General Permission** from the district of Munich. This exceptional authorization will be valid from **2 JUN to 19 JUN 2025**. Please make sure that your Team Leaders as well as athletes who arrive or depart alone carry with them the General Permission as well as the list of all registered firearms and ammunition to be presented to the customs!!!

Due to serious problems in the past, we must point out again clearly, that the **General Permission is only valid for the period mentioned above!** Arriving before 2 JUN 2025 and departing after 19 JUN 2025 is not possible! If you plan to arrive earlier or depart later a Special Permission must be ordered in time (way before 30 APR 2025).

In case you are planning a training camp, please be aware that the German Shooting Sport Federation cannot apply for that Special Permission. According to German law, the organizer of the training camp must do that.

If your stay in Munich is scheduled within the validation of the General Permission (2 JUN to 19 JUN 2025), the charge for an approved Firearms and Ammunition Declaration is **EUR 75.00 per federation**.

If the firearms and ammunition are not registered online until the deadline of **4 JUN 2025** there will be an extra late registration fee of **EUR 50.00**.

If you are **arriving before 2 JUN 2025** or **departing after 19 JUN 2025**, and will therefore need a **Special Permission**, the fee is **EUR 50.00 per federation on top + EUR 50.00 for firearm storage**. These fees must be paid together with the entry fees to the Organizing Committee.

Important:

No firearms and ammunition transport is allowed by railway or other public transport facilities!

Attention:

Due to some dangerous incidents in the past, we kindly remind all participating ISSF Member Federations that according to German law it is strictly forbidden to cook or light a fire in the hotel rooms as well as on the shooting range!

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel - Arrival

The official airport is the Munich Airport (MUC) Franz-Josef-Strauß.

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

The official pick-up service starts on the Official Arrival Day (8 JUN 2025). Delegations that arrive earlier or leave after the Official Departure Day (15 JUN 2025) must make their own arrangements.

Terminal 1

10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on 9 JUN 2025, at the Finals Hall.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Cup. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

During your stay in Germany (Munich) all firearms and ammunition must be stored in the armoury on the shooting range (also air guns and ammunition) only. The armory is open from 6 JUN – 15 JUN 2025.

It is not allowed to take any firearms and ammunition out of the shooting range and especially not to the hotels. This German law also must be followed strictly by nations that are in the possession of a European Firearms Passport (EFP)! The complete armory inventory will be checked every evening to be sure all firearms are returned!

Arrival:

Upon your arrival in Germany (Munich), all firearms and ammunition must be transported to the shooting range **in the most direct way**. All delegations entering Germany with the General Permission must store their firearms and ammunition on the shooting range **ONLY**.

Departure:

All firearms and ammunition must be transported from the armory at the shooting range to the airport in the most direct way. Even owners of a European Firearms Passport (EFP) must pick up their firearms and ammunition from the armory at the time of departure, not earlier. Please keep in mind, that in Germany even owners of a European Firearms Passport (EFP) are not allowed to leave their firearms and ammunition unattended.

Ammunition

Ammunition can be purchased at the shooting range. Please order the needed ammunition in advance (not later than **26 MAY 2025**) stating the quantity and brand. Please send an e-mail with your detailed order to kochler@dsb.de

Doping Control Tests

Doping Controls Tests will be conducted in accordance with the actual ISSF Anti-Doping Rules.

11. Ceremonies

Opening and Closing Ceremony

There will be no Opening and Closing Ceremonies.

Medal Ceremony

The Medal Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range or the Finals Hall immediately after the end of each Finals or at the end of the competition day (see also: Final Competition Schedule). During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee does not need flags and anthems from the participating ISSF Member Federations.

12. Weather Information

You may expect minimum temperatures of 18°C in the days and not less than 8°C in the nights. According to the weather forecast, May and June are considered to be two of the best months to visit Munich. Nevertheless, we experienced very hot weather with temperatures above 30°C and also very cold and rainy days. So please be sure to check the weather forecast before your departure to Munich.

13. Media Relations
