

**THE ISSF INFORMATION PORTAL ON (anti) DOPING –  
The ISSF IPOD – PARIS 2024 OLYMPIC GAMES EDITION**

The 2024 Paris Olympic Games are just around the corner!

In anticipation of the same and to allow all ISSF athletes, medical support personnel, ISSF member federations, parents etc. prepare and ensure they are aware of all their anti-doping responsibilities, ISSF is sharing for valuable educational resources with regards to anti-doping.

As you may be aware, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) has delegated the Anti-Doping Program for the Olympic Games Paris 2024 (Paris 2024) to the International Testing Agency (ITA).

Please read the below carefully and make use of all the information provided by the ITA and ISSF in anticipation of the Paris OGs.

➤ ***To all ISSF national federations:***

In education, this includes providing clean sport education support to National Olympic Committees (NOCs) who have requested it. An [NOC Clean Sport Education Guide for Paris 2024 has been published](#) and an [ITA Toolkit](#) which contains slide decks, activities, communication resources and an Education Plan template for any organisation to use.

As a National Federation, you will already be collaborating with your NOC and National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) to ensure your team understands their anti-doping rights and responsibilities leading into Paris 2024. If you would like to provide an additional layer of support, we have collaborated with the ITA to share with you the following clean sport resources and initiatives to share with your athletes and their support personnel.

➤ ***To all ISSF athletes and Athlete Support Personnel participating and attending the OGs:***

As the Olympic Games Paris 2024 approach, make sure you are fully aware of your anti-doping rights and responsibilities so you can protect your integrity.

With the support of the International Testing Agency (ITA), an independent organisation that is delivering the Paris 2024 Olympic Games Anti-Doping Program, we have put together a set of clean sport education resources to support you to fulfil your anti-doping responsibilities.
