# 3) TECHNICAL CONFORMATION RIFLE / PISTOL


All targets and systems in the R&P ranges are SIUS HS10/25/50 targets with supporting monitors and scoreboards.

All targets tested.

The ISSF Technical Delegate has inspected all Ranges, FOPs and technical equipment. They comply with technical tolerance stated and allowed for under ISSF Rules and Regulations.

#### 10m Range:

- 60 targets
- 1.00 m width of the FP.
- The height of the 10m target centres from ground level/firing point level are at 1400mm,




# 3) TECHNICAL CONFORMATION RIFLE / PISTOL

#### 50m Range:

- 60 targets
- Between 1.42 to 1.48 m width of the FP.
- The height of the 50m target centres from ground level/firing point level are at 750mm

#### 25m Range:


- 40 targets (8 sets of 5 targets)
- The height of the 25m target centres from ground level/firing point level are at 1400mm,



# 3) TECHNICAL CONFORMATION RIFLE / PISTOL

#### **Finals Hall:**

- 10 targets (10m HS10 and 50m STYX) and 3 sets of 25m targets (STYX targets)
- 2 m width of the FP for 10/50m
- The height of the 10/25m target centres from ground level/firing point level are at 1400mm,
- The height of the 50m target centres from ground level/firing point level are at 750mm



#### **Equipment Control Rifle/Pistol:**

All Athletes must have checked their equipment before the PET. Manufacturer and sponsor marks (IOC Rule 50)
Random check will be done at the range for Pistol for Rifle at the Equipment control Room or 50m range

#### Warm up Areas Dry Firing:

**Rifle and Pistol:** Warm up and the dry firing areas in 25m and 50m ranges are on right hand side and enclosed room. In 10m on left side of range. Basically, warm up on entry to ranges using athlete flows and entry doors

**Shotgun:** Warm up and aiming area is Range 5 (end range)



#### Rifle/Pistol:

#### Coach Position:

- In 10/50m, the coach chairs will be installed in front of the barrier.
- In 25m Qualification, the coach will be installed at the back of FOP.
- One coach per Athlete and monitors installed to ensure coaches can view athlete results and fall of shot

#### Boxes and bags, during actual competition:

- QR's no box and bag are permitted on the FOP
- In 50m Range the Warmup and dry firing area will be the storage during the competition.
- In 25m range, storage will be in the 10m Range Warm up area
- In 10m range, storage will be in the 25m Range Warm up area




### ATHLETE FLOWS – WHEN 10 M IS ACTIVE IN COMPETITION OR PRE-EVENT TRAINING (PET)




# ATHLETE FLOWS – WHEN 25M RANGE IS IN COMPETITION AND FINALS HALL ACCESS ALL EVENTS





- Departure Form to be completed and signed
- All Firearms remain at venue armoury until departing flights
- Logistic provider CEVA will deliver firearms to Ports of Departure
- Firearm Collection Point at each POD and Terminal
- Contact Arrivals and Departure Team in each Village, plus Sport Management NOW IN NEXT DAYS
- Start process now and contact Armoury Manager Sebastien Blanchouin
- Sport Firearms contact Eliott Maupin and Arrivals and Departures Amelie Muller

#### ROAD DEPARTURES AND FIREARMS

- All athletes <u>must delare when they have finished</u> competition to Armoury Staff
- Departure Form to be completed and signed
- All Firearms remain at venue armoury until athlete or team road departure
- Logistic support to move firearms to BOH Accredited PSAs
- Teams to follow business as usual procedures for border crossing and control

- Start process now and contact armoury manager Sebastien Blanchouin
- Sport Firearms contact Eliott Maupin and Arrivals and Departures Amelie Muller

#### **EQUIPMENT AND SUPPORT SERVICES**

- Gun Safety and Personal Control Guns
- Ammunition must be returned to store daily on departure from venue
- Normal Rules apply
- Firearms Repair in Equipment control
- Armoury Procedure: Respect the queuing
- Heavy Bag Store in Athlete lounge
- Physio spaces in Athlete lounge
- Ammunition Sales Shotgun with Training round booking

#### ATHLETE SUPPORT INFORMATION

**Armoury:** 2 lines will be organized to pickup the gun, if rush on the morning for the first event, the third line will be opened

The refilling bottles are installed at the 10m Range

Opening Times: 07:00 to 19:00 (remains operational on call silent hours). Armoury will close one hour after the end of last competition or training whichever is later

#### **Changing Room:**

Athletes must use the changing rooms, In Athlete Lounge and 50 Range for 10m and 25m Ranges

Final Hall, the Changing Rooms are opposite the reporting room. Plus, Warm up area.

#### **Storage:**

Heavy Bag Storage Area in Athlete lounge or changing rooms

No bag/box will be stored at the Qualification Ranges: 10m and 25m ranges warm up areas to be used.

#### **SPORT PRESENTATION: Athlete Head Shots:**

- Studio outside athlete lounge by mixed zone: Must visit on 30<sup>th</sup> July
- All encouraged as in best interest of athletes and Sport

### **Mixed Zones:**

- Qualification R&P: Outside Athlete Lounge in 50m Range
- Final Hall: Outside athlete call room in main office corridor
- Final Range: On raised walkway above ranges and athlete pathway
- All athletes must pass through mixed zones post competition, including qualification rounds

#### **FOOD AND BEVERAGE**

- Training all athlete lunches meals in PESI Restaurant for all regardless of Village or accommodation
- Competition all athlete lunches in PESI Restaurant +
- Athlete Venue Meals (AVMs) for athletes in competition, collected from Athlete lounge from 11:00 daily (no need to pre-order)
- Otherwise, normal drinks and snacks available in lounge and water on FOPs
- Full catering at OVC (LBP and PESI) for all daily meals

#### **TRANSPORT**

- Shuttle Transport Villages to Venue (athlete bubble to bubble)
- Daily transfer from OVP to CTX return, timings are:

OVP to CTX 05:05 and 09:05 and return CTX to OVP 10:30 and 16:00

- Transit to Paris by Train: contact Sport Info Desk in lounge
- Transport Connect (TC) from BOH area to Chateauroux Voltaire (train station)
- NOC Cars and VAPPS Not Issued here, must go through NOCs
- Venue is strictly carless when spectators are in venue: mobility vehicles and shuttles for movement or walk

- Spectator Plaza open to all client groups and accredited family
- Video screen will show all finals and TV coverage of wider Games (all sports)
- No firearms or ammunition
- Concession Shop open exclusive for athletes; Today + tomorrow 26<sup>th</sup> 10:00-13:00
- Shop open daily 10:00-16:00
- Concessions and flag of nations
