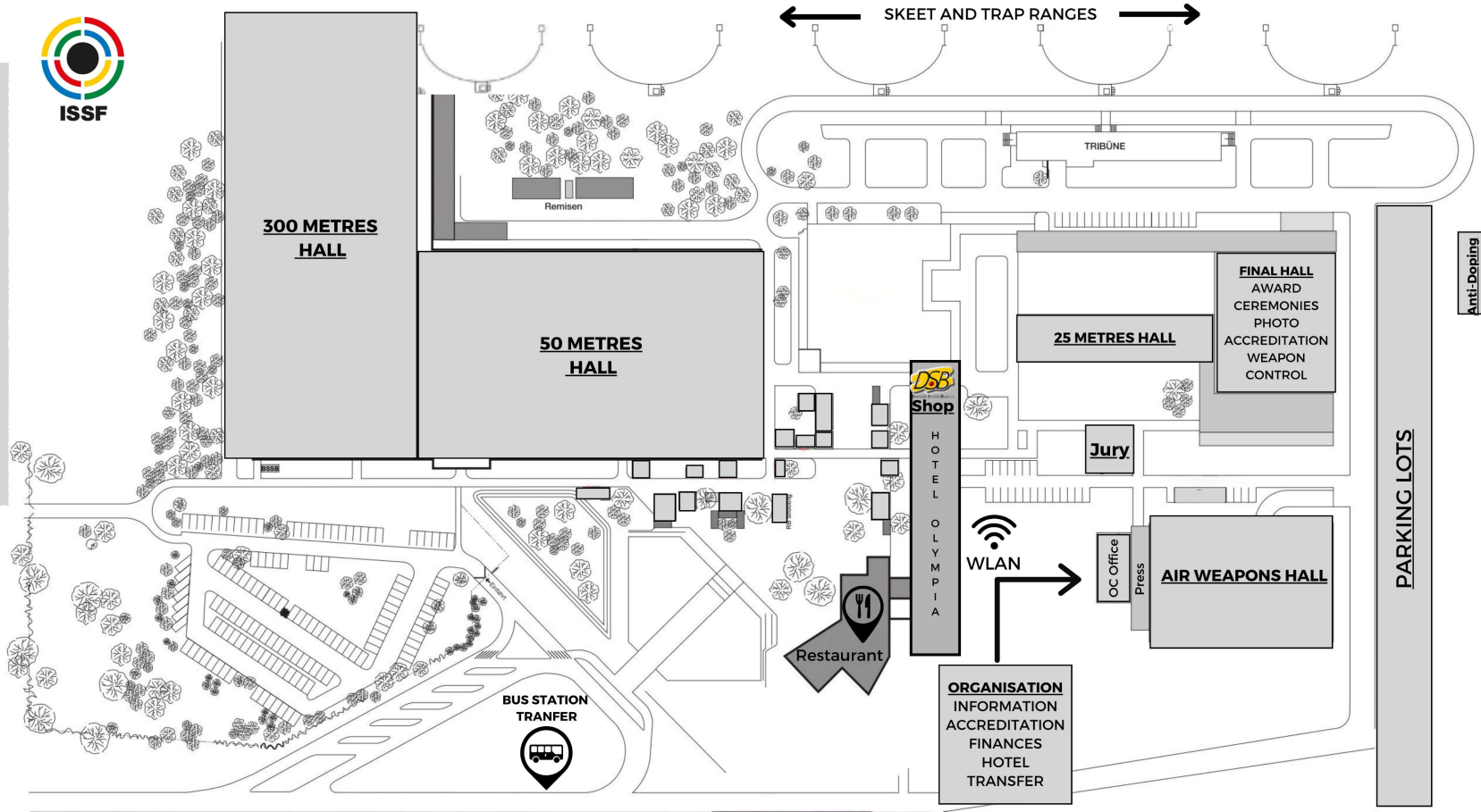

START LISTS:

- **25m Pistol Women is squadded in 3 relays**
- **25m RFP Men is squadded in 9 relays**
- **50m 3x20 M & W Qualification will have 70 athletes from Elimination relays**
- **50m 3x20 M & W, targets 41-44 not used**



SCHEDULE Information:

Final Competition Schedule is available on the ISSF website

- **Duration of the Finals RFPM and SPW from 60 minutes to 45 minutes**
- **Medal Ceremonies are always 15 min after the end of the Finals with approx. duration of 30 min for 10m individual, 45 min for 25m and 60 minutes for 50m and 10m Mixed Team Finals**
- **Mixed-Team Deadlines: 12:00h on Thursday (12.6)**



Doping Control:

Doping Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules and Regulations.

Doping tests will take place at the Archery Building next to the parking lots

EQUIPMENT CONTROL: Munich WC

- **Post-competition testing will be done**
- **Underclothing: Will be checked in post-competition testing (all clothing worn under jacket and trousers); check all doubtful clothing before the competition.**
- **Jacket and trouser stiffness: Will be checked according to established procedures; check all doubtful clothing before or after PET (consider how pre-competition tests of 3.0 or 3.1 are high risk).**

DRY FIRING:

Dry firing can be done in the Final Hall (left side/behind Equipment Control)

Definitely NO dry firing in any other places!!!

FIRING POINTS:

Firing points in 10m and 50m ranges can be occupied 25 minutes before the start of the published START time, but only on command of the Chief Range Officer.

Firing points in 25m range can be occupied 13 minutes before the Match Time, but only on command of the Chief Range Officer.

Keep firing lines clean and tidy – heavy bags to rear



ELECTRONIC TARGETS:

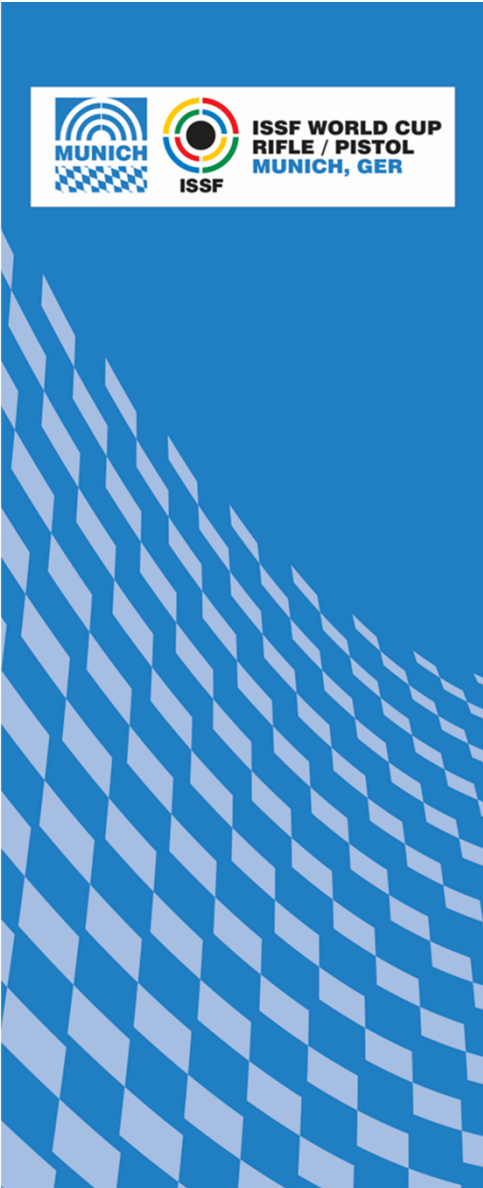
- **All targets were tested on 07.06. and 08.06., confirmed for function and accuracy according to 6.3.2.8 (testing was supervised by the RTS Jury).**
- **For 50mR 3x20 events, athletes must press the green button at the end of the sighting time to switch into match mode and also to get into the sighting target of the next position.**

Firearm Safety:

- **No guns are permitted in the hotels!!!!**
- All guns must be locked during the night in the storage room (Armoury)
- On the whole range guns may only transported in a case or a box
- No equipment bags or gun boxes or cases are allowed on the firing lines
- Please ask the CRO for advice or assistance regarding where to place these bags and boxes
