The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF World Cup is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day).

The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Shotgun Equipment

All Skeet athletes must have an ISSF seal with serial number on their Skeet marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have an ISSF seal on the Skeet marker tape must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for Shotguns or Skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Buttstock Height (for Skeet only)

The height of the buttstock (either adjustable or “Monte Carlo” type) measured from the highest point of the cheek rest to the lowest point of the butt plate toe must not exceed 170mm (17cm). Any butt plate toe vertical extension which is not an integral part of the buttstock and simply intended to increase its height, is not permitted.



Cartridge Control

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g or less, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

During Final, all eight (8) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Final and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once cartridges are placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove cartridges from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Final (There will be no elimination for 8th place; the first elimination will be for 7th place).

Colored Wads

Any ejecta (Wad), except for the shot or powder, must be transparent or translucent. The shot must not have any color added. No other element can be added that could be distinguished as a Hit Target.

Equipment Control

Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event who are competing for Medals. In addition, up to two (2) additional athletes per event can be entered to compete for Ranking Points Only (RPO). RPO starts are only possible if there are more than three (3) starts in an event.

Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

Maximum Entry / Range Capacity

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete/mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a “waiting list” for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

ISSF and Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Final Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <https://shootingsportscloud.com>.

The **Final Entry Deadline** (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is **23 FEB 2026**.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the **Late Entry Deadline** (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **21 MAR 2026**.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- Change of names / athletes within an event
- Change of status ("Medal" athlete ↔ "RPO" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **22 MAR 2026** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating ISSF Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **22 MAR 2026** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.
- Status exchange of a registered athlete for competing in the Final for Medals and of a "RPO" athlete can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (**23 FEB 2026**) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athlete and official entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Entry Fees

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

The entry fees include one (1) round of Pre-Event Training.

The entry fees DO NOT include additional costs for Pre-Event and Unofficial Training.

Payment of Entry Fees

All payments must be cash in EUR (€) to the Organizing Committee upon arrival **at the Shooting Range. Credit or debit cards or traveler's check are not accepted.**

Payment by bank transfer will **ONLY** be possible if the payment is made at least 15 days before the arrival date.

The participating federation making the bank transfer payment must indicate the country abbreviation to allow us to identify it.

A copy of the transfer document must be sent to the Organizing Committee by **9 MAR 2026**.

All bank charges must be paid by the participating federation. If there is any balance in the mentioned fees transferred, it must be paid by EUR in cash at the shooting range upon arrival.

Accreditation for Final Registration and payment is requested to be made by one (1) representative per each ISSF Member Federation. The representative must have a copy of the bank transfer for Entry Confirmation if entry fees have been paid in advance.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline) will be prepared in advance by the ISSF and Organizing Committee. During the online registration process, the ISSF Member Federations can upload pictures of their athletes and officials to be displayed on the accreditations.

There will be no possibility to take photos for accreditations on the shooting range.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

All ranges are equipped with Multi-Pull System electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is north.

The targets used for the ISSF World Cup are eco-friendly from Eurotarget, standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

The Organizing Committee is pleased to propose to the participating federations, a private space of 15m² (3m x 5m) that will be available within the club grounds. In order to compete in the best conditions, this space will provide optimal comfort conditions and all the necessary equipment for rest and maximal concentration. 7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Entry Visa

The countries which need visa, must contact their Morocco local consular services. Participants must fill and send the **Visa Support Form (Annex 6) before the deadline (not later than 23 FEB 2026)** in order to receive the nominative invitation letter which can help to obtain the visa.

Note: All fields of the form are mandatory.

Visa Information

All participants are advised to check the official Moroccan eVisa portal: www.acces-maroc.ma.

This platform provides essential guidance regarding:

- Whether a visa is required or not, depending on nationality and passport type;
- The type of visa or travel authorization applicable;
- The possibility to submit an online eVisa request when eligible.

We strongly recommend verifying this information well in advance to ensure a smooth entry process into Morocco.

Custom Formalities, Import of Firearms, Firearm License

The Organizing Committee will provide assistance at the official airport, the participating federations are advised that all teams and individuals/groups arriving separately **should carry 3 signed copies of the Individual Firearm Authorization Form (Annex 5), while both entering to / and departing from Morocco.**

Important:

To avoid any issues upon arrival, Annex 4 and Annex 5 must be completed with accurate information and submitted within the required deadlines. Any late or incorrect information provided remains the full responsibility of the participants.

The availability of rooms for accommodating all the participants of the ISSF World Cup will depend on the date of the reservation request, first come first served.

Preliminary hotel reservation can be done through the Preliminary Hotel Form (Annex 1) by **23 JAN 2026**.

Hotel reservation requests must be submitted to the travel agency before the deadline of 23 FEB 2026. Any requests received after this date will be subject to availability, and the travel agency will not be able to guarantee hotel accommodation.

The accommodation fees must be transferred to the bank account of the travel agency at the date of reservation as follows.

A 50% deposit upon receipt of the pro-forma Hotel invoice but not later than **28 FEB 2026** is mandatory. The balance will be settled upon arrival or swift in advance.

All bank fees are at the participant's expense.

Any change or cancellation must be notified to the Organizing Committee and to the Travel Agency not to the Hotels.

Reservation will not be guaranteed unless a deposit of 50% is received by the deadline **28 FEB 2026**.

Penalty fees for cancellations:

- Penalty Fees will be applicable starting from **4 MAR 2026**.
- 50% Penalty of the total cost for any reserved and canceled rooms, late arrival or early departure will be applicable from **4 to 14 MAR 2026**.
- 100% penalty of the total cost for any reserved and canceled rooms, late arrival or early departure will be applicable from **15 MAR 2026** onwards.

Food Service at the Shooting Range

Catering services will be available at the shooting range for all participants who wish to purchase meals or refreshments during the competition. These services will be offered at an additional cost and will include a variety of options to ensure comfort and convenience throughout the event.

Regarding dinners and any additional services provided by the hotels, participants are kindly requested to settle all outstanding bills directly with the hotel before their departure.

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel – Arrival

The participating federations will be received by the Organizing Committee on arrival at the following airports:

Entry into Morocco can also be made through the ports of Tanger ville and Tanger Med, but there will be no assistance.

Important:

The participants will be transported to the shooting range for firearm deposit and then will be taken to their hotels (measures of security defined by the Moroccan authorities NO DEROGATION IS ALLOWED ON THIS SUBJECT).

The participants traveling with their own vehicle must go directly to the shooting range for firearm deposit. It is strictly forbidden to take the shotgun outside of the shooting range (or to take other itineraries before the deposit).

All participants who need Airport Transfer must fill the Airport Transfer Form (Annex 7).

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

Airport Transfer will only be available for delegations who book the official hotels through the official travel agency.

Important:

Delegations who choose hotels other than the official ones must strictly follow the rules and law applicable:

The shotgun must be transported directly from the airport (or port) of arrival to the armory of the shooting range. It is strictly forbidden to take the shotgun outside of the shooting range (or to take other itineraries before the deposit).

For any special transfer/local transportation order and for the teams **arriving before the 25 MAR 2026 and departing after 3 APR 2026**, please contact the travel agency in charge of the competition wc.mar.travel@gmail.com. The fees will be at the delegations' expense.

All transportation services requested in the Airport Transfer Form (Annex 7), not cancelled within seven (7) days before arrival, will cost fees applicable by the Organizing Committee according to the number of passengers mentioned in the "Airport Transfer Form" for which the service has been required.

The Airport Transfer service will be available from 25 MAR to 3 APR 2026.

Transportation by car, minibus or bus, including firearms transportation, will be available upon arrival at the airports, at the following rates (per person):

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

Local transportation between the hotels and the shooting range will be provided free of charge by the Organizing Committee during the **competition period, from 25 MAR to 3 APR 2026**.

Please note that this local transportation will be exclusively available to delegations that have booked their accommodation through the official travel agency.

They must also confirm their departure schedule with the Organizing Committee at least 48 hours prior to departure from Morocco.

The bus is not allowed to change the itinerary related to the recommended hotels.

10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting for Skeet will take place on **26 MAR 2026** at the shooting range.

The Technical Meeting for Trap will take place on **30 MAR 2026** at the shooting range.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Cup.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

All information about participants, travel and shotguns information must be mentioned in Annex 4 and sent (excel file format) not later than 23 FEB 2026. Please submit the form fully completed. Please do not change the forms and do not use other forms. Incomplete or incorrect forms will not be accepted. **In Morocco, all firearms must be stored in the armory at the shooting range.**

Delegations are advised that all teams and individuals/groups arriving separately **should carry 3 signed copies of the Individual Firearm Authorization Form (Annex 5), while both entering to / and departing from Morocco.**

The storage of firearms in hotels and outside of the shooting range armory is strictly prohibited.

The armory will be open to facilitate the arrival of official teams until departure.

Gun Storage and Cleaning Fees:

- Safekeeping 4 €/Firearm/Day.
- Cleaning 5 €/Firearm

Ammunition

The Moroccan legislation **forbids the entry of cartridges to the country**; only licensed importers can do so. The armory of the shooting range will provide all the necessary cartridges for training and competition (see the price list below).

Doping Control Tests

Doping Controls Tests will be conducted in accordance with the actual ISSF Anti-Doping Rules.

11. Ceremonies

Opening and Closing Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on 26 MAR 2026, at 16:00h, at the shooting range. There will be no Closing Ceremony.

Medal Ceremony

The Medal Ceremonies will take place at the shooting at the end of the competition day (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

All participating federations are required to bring with them at least one (1) of their national flags (1m x 1.5m approximately) and one (1) national anthem on standard CD or USB stick (40 – 50 sec).

12. Weather Information

During this period in Tangier, daytime temperatures typically range between 17°C and 19°C, while nights remain cooler at around 10°C to 12°C. The atmosphere is generally quite humid, with relative humidity averaging around 75%. Daylight lasts for roughly 12 hours and half.

13. Media Relations
