The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

All pistols must be registered in ISSF database. Pistols that have not been registered or recorded must be checked for compliance with ISSF Rules and registered to the athlete.

Rifle Clothing

All Rifle athletes must have ISSF Seals with serial numbers on their jackets, trousers and shoes. Any jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF Seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. All existing ISSF seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates issued to jackets and trousers will cease to be valid as from 1st January 2026. All those items of clothing must be submitted to Equipment Control for testing at the first opportunity when attending an ISSF Championship so that new seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates will be issued. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified and further procedures will take place. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control. Please be aware that in some countries it is a federal offence to use outdated compressed gas cylinders.

Shotgun Equipment

All Skeet athletes must have an ISSF seal with serial number on their Skeet marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have an ISSF seal on the Skeet marker tape must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for Shotguns or Skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Buttstock Height (for Skeet only)

The height of the buttstock (either adjustable or "Monte Carlo" type) measured from the highest point of the cheek rest to the lowest point of the butt plate toe must not exceed 170mm (17cm). Any butt plate

toe vertical extension which is not an integral part of the buttstock and simply intended to increase its height, is not permitted.

Cartridge Control

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g or less, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

During Final, all eight (8) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Final and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once cartridges are placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove cartridges from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Final (There will be no elimination for 8th place; the first elimination will be for 7th place).

Colored Wads

Any ejecta (Wad), except for the shot or powder, must be transparent or translucent. The shot must not have any color added. No other element can be added that could be distinguished as a Hit Target.

Equipment Control

Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event who are competing for Medals. In addition, up to two (2) additional athletes per event can be entered to compete for Ranking Points Only (RPO). RPO starts are only possible if there are more than three (3) starts in an event.

Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

Maximum Entry / Range Capacity

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete/mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a “waiting list” for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

5. Registration Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 6) and return them by the established deadlines (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email will not be accepted.

Preliminary Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <https://shootingsportscld.com>.

The Preliminary Entry Deadline is **20 APR 2026**.

Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Final Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <https://shootingsportscld.com>.

The **Final Entry Deadline** (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is **20 JUN 2026**.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the **Late Entry Deadline** (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **16 JUL 2026**.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- Change of names / athletes within an event
- Change of status ("Medal" athlete ↔ "RPO" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **17 JUL 2026** onwards, may not participate.

Important Note: In accordance with China's firearms and ammunition regulations, athletes registering late must submit firearm and ammunition information to the Organizing Committee by **20 JUL 2026**; otherwise, the required import authorization cannot be obtained.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating ISSF Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **17 JUL 2026** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.
- Status exchange of a registered athlete for competing in the Final for Medals and of a "RPO" athlete can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (**20 JUN 2026**) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athlete and official entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Entry Fees

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

The entry fees include one (1) round of Pre-Event Training.

They DO NOT include additional costs for Pre-Event and Unofficial Training.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline) will be prepared in advance by the ISSF and Organizing Committee. During the online registration process, the ISSF Member Federations can upload pictures of their athletes and officials to be displayed on the accreditations.

There will be no possibility to take photos for accreditations on the shooting range.

Shotgun

The shooting range has four (4) combined ranges for Trap/Skeet.

The shooting range is equipped with Laporte (France) machines and Elettronica Progetti (Italy) acoustic release system. All ranges are equipped with Elettronica Progetti (Italy) electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is north.

The targets used for the ISSF World Cup are eco-friendly from Laporte (France), standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Entry Visa

The passports should be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the period of holders' intended stay in China.

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel – Arrival

Designated airports for entry: Beijing Capital International Airport (PEK), Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG) and Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport (HGH). The Organizing Committee will only provide assistance with customs clearance for competition equipment at the designated entry airports. Delegations choosing to enter China through other airports (or ports) must complete the customs clearance for competition equipment independently.

The Organizing Committee will provide transfer services at Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG) and Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport (HGH). Upon arrival of delegations at any of these two locations, their firearms and ammunition will be transported by the Organizing Committee to the designated storage area in venue.

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

For delegations arriving at and departing from Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport (HGH), the Organizing Committee is pleased to provide complimentary round-trip transfers between the airport and official hotels from **20 JUL 2026** (Official Arrival Day) through **29 JUL 2026** (Official Departure Day). For any arrivals prior to 20 JUL 2026 or departures after 29 JUL 2026, delegations are required to book the paid transfer services arranged by the Organizing Committee. The rates for various vehicle types are as follows:

Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport (HGH):

- MPV (7 seats): EUR 250
- Medium-Sized Bus (16-22 seats): EUR 300
- Coach (39 seats): EUR 350
- Coach (45 seats): EUR 380
- Coach (50 seats): EUR 400

The drive from HGH to the official hotels takes approximately 65 minutes, covering about 65 km.

For delegations arriving at Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG), the Organizing Committee can arrange chargeable transfer services confined to the transportation between PVG and the official hotels with specific fees based on the vehicle type, number of passengers and pickup/drop-off locations. The rates for various vehicle types are as follows:

Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG):

- MPV (7 seats): EUR 600
- Medium-Sized Bus (16-22 seats): EUR 650
- Coach (39 seats): EUR 750
- Coach (45 seats): EUR 780
- Coach (50 seats): EUR 810

The journey from PVG to the official hotels takes approximately 3 h 15 min, covering about 265 km.

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting for Rifle/Pistol and Skeet will take place on **21 JUL 2026** at the shooting range. The Technical Meeting for Trap will take place on **25 JUL 2026** at the shooting range.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Cup.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

To ensure the safety of firearms and ammunition for athletes participating in the ISSF World Cup Hangzhou 2026, all participating federations must comply with the following regulations:

All delegations must complete the Firearms and Ammunition Form (Annex 6), in which all rifles, pistols, shotguns, and special ammunition of corresponding calibers must be fully declared, and attach a scanned copy of each athlete's valid passport, then send it to the Organizing Committee via email by **20 JUN 2026**. Any inaccurate information will result in the team being denied entry into China. Athletes must not carry ammunition more than the declared quantity.

Upon claiming luggage, athletes must immediately proceed to the designated Customs verification area to confirm that firearm serial numbers match the declarations in the Firearm and Ammunition Form.

Important: Firearms and ammunition not pre-declared in Annex 6 or with inconsistent information will be detained by the Chinese Customs in accordance with the law.

The Organizing Committee will station special customs assistance personnel at the airport and will arrange dedicated buses and security teams for transportation. In accordance with Chinese laws and regulations, the transportation of firearms and ammunition via public transport/taxis is strictly prohibited.

Note: The accuracy of declared information directly affects customs clearance efficiency. It is strongly recommended that each delegation conduct internal review before departure to ensure the accuracy of firearm types and ammunition caliber information.

During the ISSF World Cup Hangzhou 2026, all firearms and ammunition must be stored in the designated storage area at the shooting range. The storage area will open one hour before the start of competitions and training.

Firearms and ammunition are strictly prohibited to be removed from the shooting range premises, including dining.

11. Ceremonies

Opening and Closing Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on **21 JUL 2026**. Detailed information will be provided later. There will be no Closing Ceremony.

Medal Ceremony

The Medal Ceremonies will take place at the Finals hall immediately after the end of each Finals (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

The participating ISSF member federations' national/NOC flags will be provided by the Organizing Committee. The Organizing Committee will use flags of a unified ratio (3:2), including physical and electronic flags for Medal Ceremonies, protocol events, etc. Each delegation shall provide the national/NOC flag design and basic technical parameters to the Organizing Committee for filing and verification.

The Organizing Committee will use the participating ISSF member federations' national/NOC anthems recognized by the International Olympic Committee. The national/NOC anthem shall be a version with a duration of 30-90 seconds. Each federation shall provide the national/NOC anthem that meets the duration requirement to the Organizing Committee for filing and verification.

12. Weather Information

Historically, July in Fuyang features daytime highs ranging from 32.7° C to 41.5° C, with morning lows typically between 16.7° C and 24.9° C. The long-term average monthly temperature spans 26.0° C to 32.1° C, though daily averages during comparable periods have ranged from 24.2° C to 34.4° C. July precipitation can be highly variable: the highest single-day rainfall recorded in July is 452.5 millimeters, while the average daily maximum during historical comparable periods is 64.6 millimeters.

The experience culminates in Jinzhu Village, where time slows amid the artistry of Huzhou brush-making and oil-paper umbrella craftsmanship, inviting visitors to immerse themselves in the precision, patience, and soul of traditional Chinese artisanship.

Route 2:

Guanshan Scenic Area - River Boating - Huang Gongwang's Hermitage

This riverside route unfolds along the Fuchun River, inviting travelers on an immersive journey through one of China's most celebrated landscapes. Ascending Guanshan for sweeping panoramic views of the river's serene bends and mist-kissed hills, then boarding a traditional riverboat to glide gently downstream - where "the boat drifts through the river, with the passengers in a living painting." The journey concludes at the secluded retreat of Huang Gongwang, the Yuan dynasty master painter, where winding bamboo paths and murmuring streams echo the very spirit of "*Dwelling in the Fuchun Mountains*" - his timeless masterpiece.
