The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF World Cup Rifle/Pistol 2023 Jakarta, INA is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including the Training Schedule) will distribute after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival-day). The latest schedule updates will provide in the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations. The detailed information is available on the ISSF website <u>www.issf-sports.org</u>.

The ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules, there are using approved and calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to be selected for random post-competition testing. If there are not and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules. If non-compliance with ISSF Rules is found in random post-competition testing, the athlete would be disqualified (DSQ).

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. If the jackets and trousers do not have ISSF seals, they must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be canceled. Athletes that wish to replace registered jackets or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be canceled Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be re-calibrated the panel must be re-test. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

The athlete must ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is within its validity date. This might be checked by Equipment Control.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for ranking points.

Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per mixed team event.

Team Events

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of one (1) team consisting of three members of the same gender for the team event.

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Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each ISSF World Cup event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges/firing points.

A "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established if the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first-come, first-served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID numbers will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Athlete biographies will distribute, and then the photos will be taken.

5. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 –9) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to ISSF Headquarters. Entry Forms are provided, but ISSF Member Federations are urged to use the ISSF Online Registration Service.

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All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

Preliminary Entries

ISSF Member Federations entering the ISSF World Cup must be submitted the Preliminary Entries not later than **30 NOV 2022**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <u>http://entry.issf-sport.info</u> or complete the Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1) and return it by email to <u>willi@issf-sports.org</u> or fax it to the ISSF Headquarters.

Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must forward the Final Entries directly to the ISSF Headquarters. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day) is **28 DES 2022**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <u>http://entry.issf-sports.info</u> or complete the Final Entry Forms (Annex 3) and return all those documents by email - to <u>willi@issf-sports.org</u> or fax them to the ISSF Headquarters.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (4 days before the Official Arrival day) which is **23 JAN 2023.**

Important Note: Until the 4 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

a) Change of names/athletes within the event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **23 JAN 2023** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ISSF Member Federation Delegations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official to confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00hrs on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **23 JAN 2023** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00hrs on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (**23 JAN 2022**) must pay applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Entry Fee

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between the shooting range and the official hotel, and doping control.

As for bank transfer, please identify clearly which country or federation is submitting the payment, for example, "INA Rifle" or "KOR Pistol" etc., and send copies of the transfer voucher to the Organizing Committee. The organizing committee will notify the federation of the net amount received correctly.

All bank charges must be paid by the participants. Any balance for entry fees transferred must be affected by EUR cash only at the shooting range upon arrival. Traveler's checks or credit/debit cards are NOT accepted.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, and Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photographs, family name and first name, nation, and function) to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with photographs in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the ISSF Headquarters and Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the ISSF World Cup Accreditation Office.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

6. Shooting Range

The ISSF World Cup will take place at the Senayan Shooting Range, Senayan, Jakarta, Indonesia.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

VISA

Anyone who requires an Entrance Visa to Indonesia should contact an Indonesian Embassy or Consulate at your location to obtain the Visa prior to arrival in Indonesia or you can get Electronic Visa On Arrival through the website https://molina.imigrasi.go.id.

ISSF Member Federation that requires an Official Invitation Letter to apply for a Visa, please fill in the enclosed VISA Support Form (Annex 7) and return it together with scanned copies of valid passports for all visa applicants to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but NOT later than 15 DEC **2022**. This form must be typed and clearly readable on a PC. Please submit the form completed, signed, and stamped by the federation. Please do not change or use the other forms. Incomplete or incorrect forms will be returned, and unprocessed.

Gun Permits

The ISSF Member Federations must declare all firearms brought into Jakarta, Indonesia for the ISSF World Cup in advance. The federation must fill in the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 8) clearly, sign, and stamp, and return it to the Organizing Committee by email as soon as possible but NOT later than 15 DEC 2022.

At the Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, all delegations must show Annex 8 (in triplicate) to the Customs authorities for the firearms and ammunition verification. Please bring your local import and export firearm licenses.

The official Airport for custom clearance of firearms and ammunition is Soekarno-Hatta International Airport (CGK).

The cost of the Gun Permit Fee is EUR 25.00 per weapon. This has to be wired to the OC bank account at the latest by 28 Dec 2022.

The firearms and ammunition from CGK should be brought and stored in the armory of the shooting range in Senayan.

It is strictly prohibited by the local security code that any athlete or delegation take any firearm for themselves out of the airport or to the hotel.



8. Accommodation

Official Hotel

Hotel reservations must be made through the Organizing only. The list of official hotels

Preliminary hotel Reservations must be affected by 30 NOV 2022.

Final Hotel Reservation must be affected by 30 DEC 2022.

The reservation will be considered on a "first come – first served" basis once the OC receives the duly filled Final Hotel Reservation Form (Annex 5), not the Preliminary Hotel Form. Then the OC will inform the federation of the hotel name and send the Proforma Invoice if requested. All participating federations are requested to wire a minimum of 80% of the accommodation of the total accommodating costs to the OC account by **10 JAN 2023**. However, OC may not guarantee the accommodation if the minimum of 80% of total accommodating costs is not paid by the deadline.

In case of cancellation after the Final Hotel Reservation, on **30 DEC 2022**, the Organizing Committee will charge the full costs based on your reservation (for the total room and nights).

All extra charges such as telecommunication, mini bar, extra meals, laundry, etc. that occur at the official hotels must be paid directly to the hotel at check-out.

Please note that in case any team/federation books accommodation directly, no official recognition would be given, and no official transportation would be provided by the Organizing Committee.

No payment to the ISSF or to the Hotel – Payment must be made directly to the Organizing Committee.

Food Service at the Shooting Range

Catering services will be made available at ranges against payment. For dinner and other services in the hotel, participants are requested to settle bills before departure.

9. Travel and Transportation

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotel (and return for departure)

Participants will be transported directly to Senayan Shooting Ranges to store the guns and ammunition, then taken to the official hotels. The airport pick-up/drop-off transportation is free of charge, from the official arrival to departure day.

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Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

For the delegation that accommodates at the Official Hotels through the OC, a free shuttle service will be provided between the hotels, and the shooting range from **27 JAN to 8 FEB 2023 ONLY**. A timetable of the transportation between the hotel and the shooting range will be available at the hotel information desk.

Any delegation accommodating at non-official hotels must make all their local transportation (airporthotel-shooting range) by themselves **regardless of the entry fee payment**. This will apply to any delegation who books the official hotel by themselves, not by the OC.

10. Competition-Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on 28 JAN 2023, at the Final Hall.

ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding the Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures, and other important issues related to the ISSF World Cup Rifle/Pistol 2023 Jakarta, INA. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

Unofficial Training

The shooting range will open for unofficial training with fees.

For 10m, and 50m (rifle/pistol), the unofficial training fee is 20 EUR per lane, per-three hours. For 25m, the unofficial training fee is 30 EUR per group (5 targets), per hour.

Ammunition

There is no limitation on the quantity of ammunition that participants can bring to Indonesia for training and competition during the ISSF World Cup. The amount of all ammunition brought to Indonesia must be declared to the Organizing Committee within the deadline (**28 JAN 2023**).

ISSF Member Federations are requested to contact the OC as soon as possible but not later than **10 JAN 2023** to order the necessary brand and number of ammunitions.

Please note that the OC will not be able to guarantee the availability of ammunition unless the federation finalizes the order of ammunition before the captioned deadline of **10 JAN 2023**.

Doping Control Tests

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and the ISSF Test Distribution Plan 2019 under the supervision of the ISSF Technical Delegate.

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11. Ceremonies

Opening and Closing Ceremony

According to the ISSF Temporary Regulations for Testing and Health Monitoring Methods for COVID-19, there will be no Opening and Closing Ceremony.

Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range / Final Hall immediately after the end of each Final. (See also: Final Competition Schedule at the later stage).

During the ceremonies, the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations.

12. Weather Information

During the ISSF World Cup, the temperature is expected to be 25°C to 33°C. Raining is expected on some days. The average sunlight is 12 hours/per day.

13. Media Relations

All Media representatives must register for the ISSF World Cup by using the Media Accreditation Form (Annex 9).

A Media Center will be available during the ISSF World Cup, equipped with telephone lines, e-mail service pigeonholes for information, etc. Upon arrival, athletes will be requested to fill in their Biographies and return them to the Organizing Committee. It will be possible for participants to take photos on training days. No press conferences are planned.

All Finals will be covered by ISSF TV and will be displayed on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

14. Industry Service

Firearm and equipment repair services, industry services, and industry displays, or exhibitions will be available at the range. Industry representatives are kindly requested to register with the Organizing Committee using the same registration forms that ISSF Member Federation uses by the applicable deadline.
