The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF World Cup is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day).

The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Juries, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Refereesholding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments.





Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wishto replace registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have onlyone active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

4. Participation

Individual – Rifle/Pistol

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for the ranking points

Mixed team events will be included in the Competition Schedule. These events are: 10m Air Pistol Mixed Team, 10m Air Rifle Mixed Team. ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams per

Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each ISSF World Cup event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and thenumber of available ranges/firing points.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Juniors

Juniors are athletes who will be under the age 18 years and under 21 years on the day of the opening of the Championship concerned.

Juniors may participate in one (1) category only – either in the Juniors or in the Seniors events. If no Juniors event is scheduled, Juniors may participate in this event in the Senior category.

5. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annexes 1 – 9) and <u>be sure to return them by the established deadlines.</u>

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to ISSF Headquarters. Entry Forms are provided, but ISSF Member Federations are urged to use the ISSF Online Registration Service.

All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

Final Entries

Late Entries

If the maximum numbers of athlete entries have not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival day) which is **08 APR 2023.**

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the change of names / athletes within an event in the Final Entries is possible without restriction and additional fees.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from 09 APR 2023 onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ISSF Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From 09 APR 2023 onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event is permitted and can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (11 MAR 2023) must pay applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Accreditation for final registration and payment is requested to be made by **one (1) representative** per the ISSF Member Federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to the representative to bring with him/her to the Entry Confirmation.

Special Note: Delegates are kindly requested to complete all payments by bank transfer within the deadline (11 MAR 2023) so that the entry confirmation process will run smoothly. If payments are not made in advance, it will take much longer to confirm entries and issue BIB numbers at the Accreditation Office upon arrival.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use local transportation and toenter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and who have a photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the ISSF Headquarters and Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the ISSF World Cup Accreditation Office.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Visa

Participants have to fill and send the visa support form (Annex 7) before the deadline (not later than 11 FEB 2023) in order to receive the nominative invitation letter which can help to obtain the visa.

All nations that need an official invitation from the Peruvian National Shooting Federation, must request it before 11 FEB 2023 (Annex 7). Please send an email to the organizing committee, requesting it.

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be sent by email. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

The Peruvian National Shooting Sports Federation has no influence over the embassies.

The Peruvian National Shooting Federation can provide an invitation for the WC_RP Lima 2023 period ONLY.

PLEASE TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THAT BY NATIONAL REGULATION IT'S MANDATORY THAT PASSPORTS BE VALID FOR 6 MONTHS UPON ENTERING OUR COUNTRY.

Gun License

All nations must be in possession of the approved arms import form (Annex 8), certified by the Peruvian authorities. Be sure to bring a copy of your certified weapon form with you. In addition, it is recommended that all delegations carry a list of all firearms and ammunition, which will be presented to customs agents, upon request, along with the invitation.

Please fill in the forms completely and do not change the form or use your own form. Incomplete forms cannot be accepted and will be sent back. The completed forms must be submitted to the Organizing Committee by email until 11 MAR 2023 latest.

It is MANDATORY BY LAW that all weapons, including compressed air, must be declared, as well as their ammunition (.22LR & 4.5mm).

The requirements for the temporary entry of GUNS:

- 1.- Fill out the Sucamec Affidavit form for each athlete (per weapon) if they enter with 5 guns, there must be 5 formats. LEGIBLE LETTER
- 2.- Event invitation
- 3.- Passport scanned photo
- 4.' Photo scanned Gun license
- 5.- Photo scanned Property card
- 6.'- In the event that the athlete travels with the guns of his Federation, he must attach a document of the same.

The flight itinerary of entry and exit of the country is important.

The cost for the gun registration process is EUR € 40.00.

IMPORTANT: GUNS AND AMMUNITION MUST GO DIRECTLY TO THE ARMORY OF THE SHOOTING RANGE. NO TYPE OF WEAPON, INCLUDING AIR GUNS, WILL BE ABLE TO TRANSFER THEM TO THE HOTEL OR OUTSIDE THE SHOOTING RANGE.

8. Accommodations

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel – Arrival

The official airport for pickup service at arrival and departure is Jorge Chavez International Airport.

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

The participating teams will be received by the organizing committee on arrival at Jorge Chavez International Airport in Lima. The distance between the Jorge Chavez airport and the district of Miraflores, where the official hotels are located is 22.9 km one way and it takes about 37 minutes by car.

The airport transfer services will start from 10 to 22 April 2023

Delegations that arrive earlier than the Official Arrival Day (11 APR 2023) or leave later than the Official Departure Day (22 APR 2023) must make their arrangements with the Organizing Committee. If requested in advance but not later than 01 MAR 2023, the Organizing Committee will arrange airport pick-up service at a reasonable cost. It will be subject to the number of persons and type of vehicle.

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service.

The transfer between the official hotels and the firing range is 5.7 km and takes 16 minutes on average. For the delegations who accommodate at the official hotels, free transportation service will be provided between the hotels and the shooting ranges from 11 APR to 22 APR 2023.

Delegations arriving before or leaving after the Official Departure Day of Apr 22, 2023 must make their own arrangements. Consequently, contact the OC al oc-peru@fdntp.com; eventosfdntp@gmail.com.

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on APR 12 2023, at 12:00, at the VIP ROOM of the Las Palmas Shooting Range.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, competition procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Cup. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

During your stay in PERU, for the ISSF World Cup, all firearms and ammunition must be deposited in the armory at the International Shooting Range.

It is strictly prohibited to take any air guns and air pellets out of the shooting range.

The armory will be open from 06:30 to 19:00. Every day the armory staff will check to confirm that all firearms and ammunitions were returned to the armory after training / competition.

The federations that wish to arrive earlier than 11 APR 2023 or leave later than 22 APR 2023 must pay an additional fee to use the armory, which is EUR 100.00 per federation.

This fee has to be paid to the Organizing Committee.


Opening and Closing Ceremony




