VENUE

The competition will be organized in Győr. Training and qualification will take place at AUDI Arena in Győr, Tóth László utca, whereas the finals will be held at and the Magvassy Mihály Sport Hall, Győr Kiskút liget. The two halls are located under the same roof.

SIUS Ascor electronic targets will be used for all events (Training, Qualification and Finals) as follow:

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The preliminary schedule is attached. Please note there may be changes to the timetable once entries have closed. The final schedule will be sent following the final entry's deadline. Finals will be conducted under current ISSF rules in all events.

The **Technical Meeting for juniors** will take place on **25 February 2024, at 12:45** at the final hall.

The **Technical Meeting for seniors** will take place on **27 February 2024, at 13:00** at the final hall.

Each participating ESC Member Federation should have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition Schedule, draw procedures and other important issues related to the European Championship 10m.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

5

The European Championship will be conducted according to the ESC General Regulations and the ISSF Rules and Regulations – Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org as well as on the ESC website www.esc-shooting.org. In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the valid English text shall prevail. Jury members (Competition Jury, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be nominated by ESC Presidium to supervise the European Championship. The equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF rules using approved instruments.

Rifle / Pistol/ Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory, however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jacket or trouser that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the 2024 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS 10m affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jacket and trouser that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trouser they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trouser with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

National identification/Dress code

The athletes from each nation must display their national identification on their shooting clothing as follows:

a) Rifle:

The name of the country denoted by 3 letters as determined by the IOC on their jacket pocket on the side which is turned to the audience. If the NOC is already on the shooting jacket, a National Flag should be placed or attached to the pocket facing the audience.

b) Pistol:

The name of the country denoted by 3 letters as determined by the IOC should be placed on the sleeve of the T-shirt/sports jacket on the side which is turned to the audience.

Air

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

QUOTA PLACE AND QROG

Quota places for 2024 Olympic Games Paris (FRA) will be awarded according to table below:

Results obtained during European Championships will be recognized as QROG for the 2024 Olympic Games.

Individual Events

ESC Member Federations can enter at the European Championships for Men and Women a maximum of five (5) athletes in the individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for the ranking points and Upon Arrival the Team leader must declare the (3) three athletes compete for the medals. ESC General Regulation 10.2.2.

For Juniors each Member Federation can enter a maximum of six (6) athletes in the Individual events. Two (2) of those athletes must be under the age of eighteen (18) years on the day of the official arrival day of the Championship concerned. A maximum of three (3) athletes of one nation (the three top- ranked after Qualification) may proceed to the Final.

ESC General Regulation 10.2.3.

Mixed Team Events

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams, consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per mixed team event. Mixed team members must represent the same country. No mixed nation teams are allowed. One (1) bronze medal will be awarded.

Team Events

The registration of the athletes in the Team Events (each team will be composed of 3 members). The Mixed Teams and Teams must be composed of participants of the respective individual events among M and W or MJ and WJ. One (1) bronze medal will be awarded in team events.

Juniors

Athletes will remain as juniors until the 31st December of the year in which they become 21 years of age. Any athlete born between the 1st January and the 31st December, will cease to be a junior on the 31st December of that year.

ISSF Rule Book 3.7.4.12.

Maximum Entry per event

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for 2024 European Championship 10m. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges/firing positions. If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, the final schedule will be adapted.

PRELIMINARY ENTRIES

ESC Member Federations participating in the 2024 European Championship 10m must submit their Preliminary Entries not later **than December 1, 2023**.

For Preliminary Entries please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info> or exceptionally complete the attached Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1.1) and return it to the ISSF Headquarters by fax or email and to the Organizing Committee email: gyor2024@hunshooting.hu

Final entry registration for athletes and officials must be made by online ISSF registration at <http://entry.issf-sports.info> not later **than January 24, 2023**

LATE ENTRIES

9

Any late entry accepted after the 30-day final entry deadline will incur an additional late entry fee for each athlete, each Mixed Team or Team entered in each event.

Any additional entries received after the deadline of three (3) days before the official arrival day i.e., **February 21, 2024 will not be taken into consideration.**

REPLACEMENT

10

Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete for the Championship is permitted. This change can only be **made before 12:00 pm (noon) on the day before the pre-event training for that event.**

ENTRY CONFIRMATION UPON ARRIVAL

11

All Team Leaders is required to report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. This confirmation must take place before 12:00 on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

CANCELLATION

12

Any ESC Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and/or officials after the final entry **deadline January 24, 2024** is obliged to pay all applicable fees and costs including entry fees according to the number of entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

ISSF ID NUMBER

13

According to ESC General Regulations, all athletes must have an official ISSF ID number before participation in any ESC Championship. No athlete without an ISSF ID Number will be allowed to participate. ESC General Regulation 10.1.1.

The accreditation for all participants, officials will take place at AUDI Arena. Guests and members of the independent press will be placed to our partner hotels outside of the venue. Accreditations will be prepared by the Accreditation and Payment Office of 2024 European Championship. Accreditations and BIB numbers will be distributed after full payment of the entry fees and accommodation.

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

All bank transfers must be made in EUR and must include any fees the bank may charge. Please take care that all necessary data are indicated, so that the Organizing Committee can assign payments to the correct federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer slip to your Team Leader to bring it as proof of payment to the Entry Confirmation at accreditation.

Delegations will be accommodated at selected 3* and 4* hotels and apartments located in a range of 0 - 12 km from the venue. All room and airport transfer reservations have to be made through the booking website of the official travel agency Well Travel. TRANSPORTATION

18

LOC's contracted partner, Well Travel Agency will provide transportation service from Vienna/Budapest Airport to the official hotel, and from the hotel to the shooting range during the duration of the Championship. The travelling time to/from the shooting range from/to the hotels is approximately 20 min.

Arrival & Departure Transport Service and daily transfers (airport – hotel - airport) will be provided between the designated official arrival and departure days (February 24 and March 3, 2024) only. Transportation fee from Vienna/Budapest Airport to the hotel and Hotel to ranges and from hotels to the Vienna/Budapest Airport is 85, - EUR/one way.

Any teams travelling outside of the official arrival and departure days are required to contact the LOC for their arrangements. This transportation is including the transfer of firearms and ammunition from the airport to the armory of the shooting range.

Participating federations are responsible to obtain a visa if needed. Please contact the organizers for the official invitation letter if needed. European Union citizens will be able to enter Hungary with a valid passport or identity card. Non-European Union citizens are advised to check the visa requirements well in advance.

Each participating federation requiring visa should fill out the "Visa Support Form" (see Annex 8) and return it to the Organizing Committee within the deadline. Personalized invitation might be necessary for your delegation to apply for a visa.

IMPORT OF WEAPONS

20

The temporary import of air weapons to Hungary requires no official import procedures whatsoever however team leaders are recommended to have the invitation letter and the list of weapons duly stamped by their federation with them in case any unforeseen event/procedure might take place at airports and/or border points.

INSURANCE

21

Please kindly note that all team members (including competitors, technical staff, officials, and supporters) attending this event are kindly requested to ensure they have personal, medical and travel insurance as the event will not indemnify individual claims.

DOPING CONTROL

22

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and the ISSF Test. Distribution Plan 2022 under the supervision of the ESC Technical Delegate.

CEREMONIES 23

The Victory ceremonies will take place daily after the finals at the Victory area in the Final Hall.

EXHIBITIONS 24

Firearms and equipment manufacturers with their service facilities will be present during the official days of the 2024 European Championship at the shooting range.

MEDIA CENTER 25

All media representatives of the relevant ESC countries will be invited through the ESC member federations. Before attending the Championship, all media representatives must register by sending the Media Accreditation Form (Annex 4) to the Organizing Committee within the deadline February 03 2023.


