The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024 is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including the Training Schedule) will be distributed after the **Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day)**.

The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

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3. Rules and Regulations

The Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024 will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and General Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website <u>www.issf-sports.org.</u>

Jury members (Jury of Appeal, Competition Juries, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designed by the Asian Shooting Confederation (ASC) to supervise the Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024. The qualified Range Officers holding applicable ISSF will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment control will be conducted according to ISSF rules, using approved calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, the athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and affixing a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid, except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace registered jackets or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. The athlete must be disqualified if two or more panels fail (DSQ).

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

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The athlete must ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

Equipment Control

Equipment control will be open to the athletes as scheduled in the Program of the competition.

Juniors may only participate in one category – either in the juniors' or seniors' events. (ASC Rules 6.1.2)

5. Participation

Entries are open for ASC Member Federations only and each participant must be registered officially by their federation.

ASC Member federation may enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals other two (2) can only compete for the ranking point. Two (2) Mixed Teams in respective Mixed Team events but only one (1) of them can go (highest ranking team) to compete in the Final for the medals and one (1) Team in the respective Team events (ASC Rules 7.6.2).

The ASC member federations may enter a maximum of one (1) team per team event, consisting of three (3) athletes.

All athletes participating must have an ISSF ID number. All athletes without the ISSF ID number are not allowed to participate in the competitions.

Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each Asian Shooting Championship event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges/firing points. If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the OC will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

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6. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 9) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to **ISSF Headquarters**. Entry Forms are provided, but ASC Member Federations are urged to use the ISSF Online Registration Service. All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: **"Summary of Deadlines").**

Preliminary Entries

ASC Member Federations entering the Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024 must submit the Preliminary Entries no later than 07 OCT 2023. Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service http://entry.issf-sports.info, or exceptionally complete the Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1) and return it by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters: willi@issf-sports.org

Final Entries

ASC Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the ISSF Headquarters. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day) is **06 DEC 2023**. Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service http://entry.issf-sports.info, or exceptionally complete the Final Entry Forms (Annex 3) and return them by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters: marco.mori@issf-sports.org

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **02 JAN 2024.**

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names/athletes within an event
- b) Change of Status ("Regular" athlete \leftrightarrow "Ranking Points Only" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **02 JAN 2024** onwards, may not participate.

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Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ASC Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00 on the day before the Pre-Event Training of the corresponding event.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **02 JAN 2024** onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between the shooting range and the official hotel, and doping control.

Unofficial Training Fee

The shooting ranges will be open for unofficial training with costs. The reservation for unofficial training from 05 JAN to 17 JAN 2024 should be made one (1) day before your request for the financial team in the shooting range in USD cash only or by bank transfer in advance and the fees will be USD 20 per person per lane for two (2) hours.

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Payment of Entry Fees

All payments must be made to the Organizing Committee, not the ISSF or ASC. ASC Member federation are request to pay entry fee and firearm permit fees by bank transfer is US Dollars Currency (USD) by 21 December 2023.

The IBAN or BIC is not assigned to local banks in Indonesia. The ASC Member Federation can transfer all fees to the above account by using the Swift code, instead of IBAN or BIC.

As for bank transfer, please identify clearly which country or federation is submitting the payment and send copies of the transfer voucher to the Organizing Committee by 21 December 2023 in order for the OC to notify the federation of net amount received correctly.

All bank charges must be paid by the participants. Any balance for entry fees transferred has to be effected by US Dollars Cash only at the shooting range upon arrival. No traveller's checks or credit/debit cards will be accepted.

Accreditation for final registration and payment is advisable to be made by one (1) Representative per ASC Member Federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to the representative to bring with him/her to the Entry Confirmation.

7. Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ASC Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and who have a photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Championship Accreditation Office at the shooting range.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment

of the entry fees.

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8. Shooting Range

The Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024 will take place at the Senayan Shooting Range, Senayan, Jakarta, Indonesia.

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VISA

Anyone who requires an Entrance Visa to Indonesia should contact an Indonesian Embassy or Consulate at your location to obtain the Visa before arrival in Indonesia or you can get Electronic Visa on Arrival Through the website <u>https://molina.imigrasi.go.id</u>.



ISSF Member Federation that requires an Official Invitation Letter to apply for a Visa, please fill in the enclosed **VISA Support form (Annex 7)** and return it together with scanned copies of valid passports for all Visa applicants to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but not later than **06th December 2023**. This form must be typed and readable on a PC. Please submit the form completed, signed, and stamped by the federation. Please do not change or use the other forms. Incomplete or incorrect forms will be returned, and unprocessed.

Gun Permits

The ASC Member Federations must declare all firearms brought into Jakarta, Indonesia for the ISSF World Cup in advance. The federation must fill in the **Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 8)** clearly, sign, and stamp, and return it to the Organizing Committee by email as soon as possible but NOT later than 25 NOV 2023.

At the Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, all delegations must show **Annex 8** (in triplicate) to the Customs authorities for the firearms and ammunition verification. Please bring your local import and export firearm licenses.

The official Airport for custom clearance of firearms and ammunition is Soekarno-Hatta International Airport (CGK).

The cost of the Gun Permit Fee is USD 25.00 per weapon. This must be wired to the OC bank account at the latest by 21 DEC 2023.

The firearms and ammunition from CGK should be brought and stored in the armory of the shooting range in Senayan.

It is strictly prohibited by the local security code that any athlete or delegation take any firearm for themselves out of the airport or to the hotel.

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10. Accommodations

Official Hotel

Preliminary hotel Reservations must be affected by 07 OCT 2023.

Final Hotel Reservation must be affected by 06 DEC 2023.

The reservation will be considered on a "first come – first served" basis once the OC receives the duly filled **Final Hotel Reservation Form (Annex 5)**, not the Preliminary Hotel Form. Then the OC will inform the federation of the hotel name and send the Proforma Invoice if requested. All participating federations are requested to wire a minimum of 80% of the accommodation of the total accommodating costs to the OC account by **21 DEC 2023**. However, OC may not guarantee the accommodation if the minimum of 80% of total accommodating costs is not paid by the deadline.

In case of cancellation after the Final Hotel Reservation, on **06 DEC 2023**, the Organizing Committee will charge the full costs based on your reservation (for the total room and nights).

All extra charges such as telecommunication, mini bar, extra meals, laundry, etc. that occur at the official hotels must be paid directly to the hotel at check-out.

Please note that in case any team/federation books accommodation directly, no official recognition would be given, and no official transportation would be provided by the Organizing Committee.

No payment to the ISSF or the Hotel – Payment must be made directly to the Organizing Committee.

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11. Travel and Transportation

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotel (and return for departure)

Participants will be transported directly to Senayan Shooting Ranges to store the guns and ammunition, then taken to the official hotels. The airport pick-up/drop-off transportation is free of charge, from the official arrival to departure day.

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

For the delegation that accommodates at the Official Hotels through the OC, a free shuttle service will be provided between the hotels and the shooting range from **05 JAN to 18 JAN 2024 ONLY**. A timetable of the transportation between the hotel and the shooting range will be available at the hotel information desk.

Any delegation accommodating at non-official hotels must make all their local transportation (airport-hotel-shooting range) by themselves **regardless of the entry fee payment**. This will apply to any delegation who books the official hotel by themselves, not by the OC.

12. Competition-Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on **06 JAN 2024**, at the Final Hall.

The ASC Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding the Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

Ammunition

There is no limitation on the quantity of ammunition that participants can bring to Indonesia for training and competition during the Asian Rifle/Pistol Championships 2024. The amount of all ammunition brought to Indonesia must be declared to the Organizing Committee within the deadline (06 DEC 2023).

13. Ceremonies

Opening and Closing Ceremony

The opening Ceremony will take place on **06 JAN 2024** by the guidance of COVID-19 Rules and Regulations by the local government. The time and place will be noticed at a later stage. No Closing Ceremony will not be held.

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Victory Ceremony

Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range immediately after each Final Hall (see also: Final Competition Schedule at the later stage).

During the ceremonies, the athletes who receive awards are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

National Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations. OC will arrange them in advance and verify them through the Team representative at the shooting range.

14. Weather Information

During the Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024, the temperature is expected to be 25°C to 33°C. Raining is expected on some days. The average sunlight is 12 hours/per day.

15. Media Relations

All Media representatives must register for the Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024 by using the Media Accreditation Form (Annex 9).

A Media office will be available at the shooting range during the Asian Rifle/Pistol Championship 2024, equipped with internet, telephone, and fax connection. No press conferences are planned.

Finals will be covered by local TV and will be displayed on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

16. Industry Service

The Organizing Committee will provide industry services and displays or exhibitions wishing to make them at the shooting range. The industry or company wishing to use a booth at their own cost for exhibition or product sales is required to contact the OC directly for further details and costs.


